

Title: Family Physicians Should Be Paid for Valuable Activities

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- WHEREAS, family physicians have a significant impact on patient lives when they are able to take time to encourage
- 2 better behaviors, and
- 3 **WHEREAS**, family physicians have new treatments and technology that can impact patient health, and
- 4 WHEREAS, when family physicians integrate patient coaching, exercise counseling, group educational activities,
- 5 care management, prompting certain behaviors or imparting education by texting and sharing education videos, they
- 6 provide value, and
- 7 WHEREAS, phone calls and e-visits have become acceptable substitutes for some face-to-face encounters, and
- 8 **WHEREAS**, phone calls and e-visits presently require the expenditure of resources but are not typically reimbursed
- 9 by Medicare, Medicaid, or commercial health plans, now, therefore, be it
- 10 **RESOLVED**, that Michigan Academy of Family Physicians ask the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP)
- to use significant and necessary resources to encourage family physicians to integrate patient coaching, care
- 12 management, exercise counseling, group educational activities, prompting certain behaviors or imparting education
- by texting and sharing education videos; and, be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, that Michigan Academy of Family Physicians ask American Academy of Family Physicians to advocate
- that the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to accept these activities and that, as new and cutting-edge
- physician services, they be compensated well enough to support infrastructure development and a profit for the
- family physicians providing these services.
