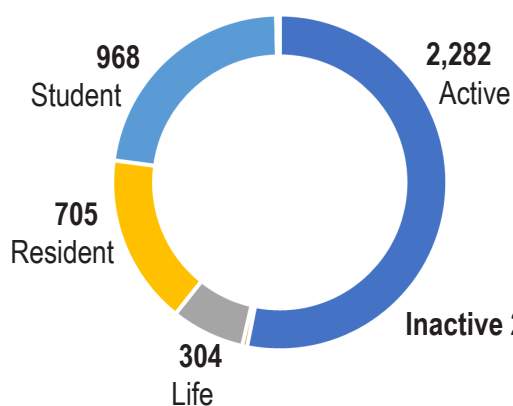

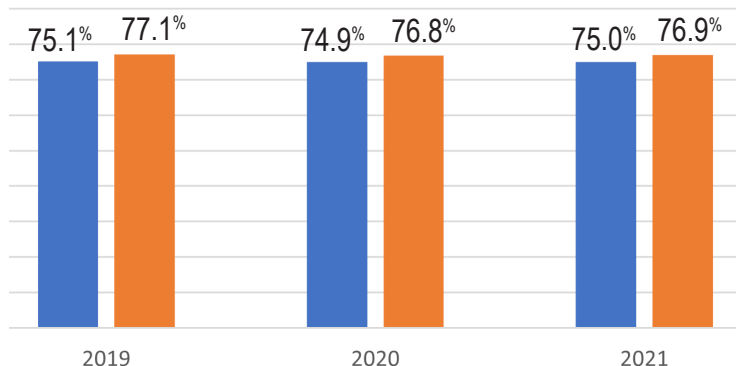

### MEMBERSHIP BY TYPE



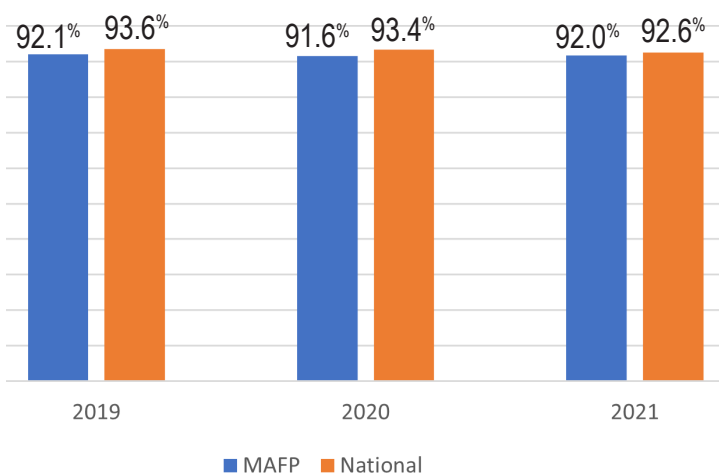
### ANNUAL MARKETSHARE
