1. Go to MAFP's website at <u>mafp.com</u> and login with your MAFP username (email address) and password (if you don't know your password, you may select to reset it).

2. On the Welcome webpage, click My MAFP Profile.

3. Within your profile, click the blue Edit Profile button.

4. Scroll to the bottom of the page, where you will find the field titled Speakers Bureau—key in your area(s) of interest/subspecialty.
