The new officers and directors were sworn in and took the oath of office led by AAFP Board Chair LeRoy.

### **Installation of New President**

Srikar Reddy, MD, FAAFP was sworn in as 2021-2022 MAFP President by AAFP Board Chair LeRoy. Mark “Mustafa” Hamed, MD, MBA, MPH, FAAFP assumed the role of Board Chair.

### **Consideration of Resolutions**

Speaker Nagappala began consideration for resolutions submitted to MAFP from membership. Following Speaker Nagappala reading each resolved clause, resolution authors were invited to speak on behalf of their resolutions.

**Resolution 21-01** – Following testimony from Lauren Oshman, MD, MPH, FAAFP, a motion to amend the first resolved clause and add, “and to expand covered access to intensive behavioral therapy for obesity,” and the third resolved to add “Medicaid, and expand access,” was made by Robert Jackson, MD, MMM, FAAFP and seconded by David Walsworth, MD, FAAFP. **Motion carried.** A second motion was made by Keerthy Krishnamani, MD, MBA and supported by Stephen Warnick Jr., MD, FAAFP to add “Tier 1” to the second resolved clause. **Motion carried.** A motion was made by Lauren Oshman, MD, MPH, FAAFP and seconded by Stephen Warnick Jr., MD, FAAFP to adopt the resolution. **Motion carried.**

**Resolution 21-02** – Aisha Harris, MD gave testimony on the resolution she authored. During discussions of the resolution, and a motion was made to refer the resolution to the MAFP Board of Directors by Keerthy Krishnamani, MD, MBA and seconded by Srikar Reddy, MD, FAAFP. **Motion carried.**

**Resolution 21-03** – Following testimony from resolution author Loretta Leja, MD, and a motion was to adopt the resolution by Loretta Leja, MD and seconded by Keerthy Krishnamani, MD, MBA. **Motion carried.**

**Resolution 21-04** – Following testimony from resolution author Loretta Leja, MD, and a motion was to adopt the resolution by Loretta Leja, MD and seconded by Erin Hendriks, MD, FAAFP. **Motion carried.**

**Resolution 21-05** – Erin Hendriks MD, FAAFP gave testimony on the resolution she authored. A motion was made to adopt the resolution by Erin Hendriks, MD, FAAFP and seconded by Stephen Warnick Jr., MD, FAAFP. **Motion carried.**

**Resolution 21-06** – Following testimony from student member Adjoa Kusi-Appiah, a motion to amend the resolved clause to read, “...within Michigan’s school sex education curriculum beyond abstinence,” was made by Keerthy Krishnamani, MD, MBA and seconded by Adjoa Kusi-Appiah. **Motion carried.** A second order amendment was made by Pamala Rockwell, DO, FAAFP and supported by Keerthy Krishnamani to add “evidence-based” as a modifier to sexual education resources in the second line. **Motion carried.** A second motion was made by Beena Nagappala MD, MPH and supported by Pamala Rockwell, DO, FAAFP to add a second resolved clause “Resolved that Michigan Academy of Family Physicians support and encourage the inclusion and dissemination of comprehensive evidence-based sexual education resources within Michigan’s school-based clinics beyond abstinence.” **Motion carried.** A third motion was made by Elizabeth Tree-LeVasseur, MD and seconded by Holli Neiman-Hart, MD, FAAFP to add an addition resolved clause “Resolved, that Michigan’s School sexual education curriculum is recognized that abstinence is seen as the best and first choice and in agreement with personal values of individual families.” **MOTION FAILED.** A motion was made by Semera Shemsu and seconded by Kristi VanDerKolk, MD, FAAFP to adopt the resolution. **Motion carried.**

### **Presidential Farewell Address**

Outgoing MAFP President Mark “Mustafa” Hamed, MD, MBA, MPH, FAAFP gave his farewell address, thanking members for their support through the challenges and successes in the past year given COVID-19 complications and how public health has been a great focus for MAFP this year.

### **Presidential Welcome Address**

Following being formally elected, President Reddy gave brief remarks to the membership, outlining his gratitude for support and desire to grow on the successes of his predecessors.

A motion was made by Elizabeth Tree-LeVasseur, MD to reconsider Resolution 21-05 to offer additional testimony due to technology problem. No second was made to move the motion for a vote.

A motion to adjourn was made by Robert Jackson, MD, MMM, FAAFP and supported by Jinping Xu, MD, FAAFP.
